

Riegelman TIPH Global Grant Program

Launched in 2008 by the Association of Schools and Programs of Public Health (ASPPH), the This Is Public Health® (TIPH) campaign aims to raise awareness about the field of public health and the professions it encompasses. Over time, TIPH has gained momentum and, in 2021, ASPPH expanded this effort under the auspices of the Global Network for Academic Public Health (GNAPH), with the TIPH Global campaign. GNAPH is an alliance of seven regional

associations representing schools and programs of public health around the world. Between our associations, we represent over 500 schools and programs of public health, located in more than 100 different countries around the globe.

















The now-named Riegelman TIPH Global Grant Program, generously supported by Dr. Richard and Mrs. Linda Riegelman, provides awards to academic public health institutions around the world to develop campaigns that increase the visibility of public health worldwide, with an emphasis on local communities. Applicants must be an academic public health institution that is a member of a regional association belonging to GNAPH.

Cohort 3 is Open for Applications!

The application cycle for the third cohort of the Riegelman TIPH Global Grant Program is now open. This two-year grant program will provide up to twelve (12) awards of up to US \$5,000 to academic public health institutions to develop Riegelman TIPH Global campaigns around the world. Award notifications will be sent in April 2025 and the grant period will begin in May.
