Dr. Laurent Chambaud is the dean of EHESP French School of Public Health. Dean Chambaud is a public health physician and former advisor to Ms. Marisol Touraine, the Minister of Social Affairs and Health. He began his career in the service of maternal and child health (MCH) in 1979. Then he was trained as a medical inspector of public health at the National School of Public Health (NPHS) in 1988. In 1996, Dean Chambaud was appointed national expert seconded to the European Commission and the project coordinator for the establishment of the National Institute of Health Surveillance (INVS). After passing the General Inspectorate of Social Affairs from 2006 to 2010, Dean Laurent Chambaud was appointed director of the Public Health Regional Health Agency of Ile-de-France, and joined the cabinet of Ms. Marisol Touraine.
