Athens, May 25-27, 2016

Purpose & Structure: The ASPHER 2016 meeting of Deans and Directors of Schools of Public Health in the European Region is a very special event as ASPHER celebrates its 50th birthday. Half of century of successful collaboration and dedicated contributions led ASPHER to become the strong and vibrant association it is today. Public Health and Schools of Public Health have experienced many challenges and transitions over the last decades such as the reunification of Germany and the opening of borders within Europe, the financial crisis and austerity, other social phenomena like refugee and population movements which trigger various types of crises, and shifts in paradigms with regard to health. Schools of Public Health must be ready for times of crises, and have strategies to face challenges ahead. Increasing social inequalities, climate change, and emerging epidemics are amongst the challenges of the future. To tackle these challenges, the ASPHER 2015 General Assembly adopted a new strategy, ASPHER 2020, which defines priorities in education, training, strengthening research capacities for the years ahead, and strongly promotes the success of Schools of Public Health. ASPHER emphasizes the perspective of the younger generation as they are the ones to solve the public health challenges of the future and set the course of action.

During the Athens' meeting 2016, the main themes include:

- (i) professionalization of public health in cooperation with partner associations,
- (ii) the role of the schools in the implementation of ASPHER 2020,
- (iii) promotion of global collaboration, and
- (iv) learning from the past to construct the future of public health.

**Outcome:** The main outcome of the Retreat will be oriented towards active involvement of all members in the implementation of the ASPHER 2020 strategy. It is expected that the Retreat will also contribute to an ASPHER policy brief series, resulting in a published volume in 2016. Finally, the Athens Accord will instill ASPHER members' commitment to the new strategy. In discussing, strategizing, and most importantly celebrating this marvelous moment in ASPHER's rich history, a good time will be had by all!


