## **An Introduction**

The COVID-19 Contact Management Programme (CMP) was established in March 2020 to respond to the global pandemic in Ireland

The Contact Tracing Centre in UCD was established in March 2020 as the first satellite CTC nationally, initially with over 200 volunteers from a variety of backgrounds, including Public Health, Nursing, Physiotherapy Medicine, Dietetics, Laboratory Science.

Over the last 17 months under the leadership of Prof. Mary Codd and Prof. Patrick Wall, the UCD CTC has played a vital role in the State's contact tracing programme, including managing the specialised queue on behalf of the Departments of Public health and many of the complex, clinical and sensitive cases.
