

# CBHE Meeting Takeaways

- Focus on impact
  - When faced with a choice, choose what will make the most impact
- Take sustainability into account from the very beginning
  - Make sure results will continue to have a positive effect after project period
  - Engage stakeholders for after project period
- Avoid disengagement

# Considerations for reporting

- Financial items
  - 10% flexibility to move budget to other items
  - All reporting must be converted to Euros
  - No cash payments
  - Avoid double billing
  - Keep all documentation for 5 years past project end date
- Timesheets
  - Fill timesheets out from the beginning
  - Staff cost categories apply to the type of work carried out
- COVID adjustments
  - Try to work within the 10% budget flexibility
  - Recommended to adjust for the next 6 months only

# Considerations for reporting

- Equipment
  - Only beneficiary country HEIs can buy equipment
  - Buy equipment early - purchases in the final year will be ineligible
  - All equipment must have the ERASMUS+ label
- Communications must always carry the ERASMUS+ logo



- Project website
  - Should be online in first 2-3 months
  - Make timely updates of activities and results
  - Do not include internal working documents

4. Building LEADERSHIP capacity via cutting edge training in the Israeli public health schools and programmes.
5. Stakeholder engagement to secure key OUTREACH (community, inter-professional, cross-sectoral).
