It is largely absent from health workforce policy and the European and national pandemic recovery plans and debates over health system resilience. A trans-sectoral and multi-professional governance approach may help us better understand the different forms of violence and the factors that worsen the attacks.

This webinar is a call for unity and mobilisation, where our speakers will identify opportunities to better address the increasing violence against healthcare workers.
