Abstract:

The Association of Schools of Public Health in the European Region (ASPHER) is the key independent European organisation dedicated to improving and protecting the public health by strengthening education and training of public health professionals for both practice and research. ASPHER is a robust membership organisation of institutions, spread across the EU and wider across the World Health Organization (WHO) European Region, which are collectively concerned with the education and training, and professionalism, of those entering and working within the public health workforce. There is consensus on the urgent need to build health workforce capacity to deliver Essential Public Health Functions, including emergency preparedness and response. Strengthening competency-based education and training for the public health workforce is at the heart of this effort. With this proposal for the EU4H Call for proposals for operating grants to NGOs (EU4H-2023-OG), ASPHER is thus seeking to support our members and improve their ability to train the workforce needed to promote health and to respond to current and emerging health threats. Moreover, for public health to reach its highest potential collaboration is required across the public health community. This proposal plans to promote synergy and consolidation across public health networks for better impact and sustainability, and making public health an attractive career choice with pathways for progression and advancement. In this considered proposal, responsible financial planning is reflected in the Association's reasoned and rational approach to the operating grant budget request, reflecting a sum that is within the Association's means to sustain while boosting the capacity for crucial operating areas and digital infrastructure that require concerted attention.
