Porto's 1899 Bubonic Plague Tour

In 1899, Porto was the first city in Europe to be hit by the third wave of the bubonic plague, enduring a sanitary siege imposed militarily by the national government for four months. Around the city, we will visit some historical places where the plague left its marks.
