#### **2020 Climate Action Survey**

An <u>online survey</u> was distributed, asking ""How can the Association of Schools of Public Health in the European Region (ASPHER) best support the goals of the European Green Deal through its network of public health schools and departments?". The findings provided ASPHER a situational analysis of trends, perceptions and actions within the network.

#### **2021 ASPHER Climate-Health Fellowship**

ASPHER Secretariat officially establishes a climate-health stream for its fellowship programme. ASPHER Climate Health Fellows include Rana Orhan (2021-2022) and Tara Chen (2022-Present). Currently, ASPHER's Climate Health Lead, Dr. Laurent Chambaud supports the supervision of this fellowship programme, alongside ASPHER Young Professionals Constanța Craveț & Marie Nabbe.

ASPHER builds on the GCCHE's Climate & Health Key Competencies for Health Professions Students by bringing it to the context of the European Region.

## 2021 EU Health Policy Platform & Joint Statement (2022)

ASPHER is selected as a 2021 thematic network and releases a joint statement in **2022** that was presented to the EU Commission with over 80 endorsements, "<u>Moving towards the right to 'health for all' by training the public health and wider health workforce on climate change and health</u>.

#### **2022 ASPHER Climate-Health Working Group**

ASPHER officially launches an internal working group dedicated on climatehealth education, practice, and research. ASPHER continues to zsupport climate-health through other partnerships including IANPHI Climate Change & Health Committee, EU Planetary Health Alliance, etc.



# **2022 ASPHER applies for COP28 Observer Status**

During COP26, ASPHER was able to send the Climate-Health Fellow to attend activities outside of the venue. In the summer of 2022, ASPHER's Climate-Health Team submits an application for ASPHER to receive Observer Status for the COP28 cycle.

#### **2023 European Climate and Health Observatory**

ASPHER officially joins observatory, which is a partnership between the European Commission, the European Environment Agency (EEA) and others. The Observatory contributes to the European Green Deal and the EU4Health vision for a healthier European Union.

#### **2023 ASPHER Core Competencies & Curriculum Programme**

ASPHER's Dr. Mary Codd & Fellow Karl Conyard are currently updating ASPHER's curriculum, including sections on climate, environmental health and one health.

### 2023 EU Responder Course (Flagship Initiative)

ASPHER's Climate-Health Working Group has partnered up with the Global Consortium of Climate Change and Health (GCCHE) to develop a free, online 8 week course to build climate-health literacy among health professionals. Following a 1 hour lecture, 2 case studies format, the course is focused on the EU context, launching in early 2024.
