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Education at all faculties takes place in accordance with the Bologna Convention and the European Qualifications Framework

Diplomas issued by the Wroclaw Medical University are equivalent to the diplomas of other universities in the European Union and give the right to pursue medical professions throughout the European Union



Faculty of Health Sciences

Education in the fields of physiotherapy, public health, dietetics and emergency medical services is not regulated by the education standard, and therefore every university in Poland and in Europe can independently shape the competence profile of the graduate

Due to the fact that a graduate of each university may have a different set of competences, he or she receives a description of the competences they obtained during the education (so-called supplement) together with the diploma

These competences are described in the groups: Knowledge, Skills

PRACTICAL TRAINING takes place during the academic year as well as during the summer break

The clinical basis for practical exercises are clinical and multidisciplinary hospitals in Wroclaw and the Lower Silesia Voivodship, as well as hospitals and clinics in other places in Poland and abroad, if students organize their own practice there (eg in the last year, WNoZ students have been practicing in the Germany, Ukraine, France, USA)

Before starting the clinical exercises, students gain competences and experience in the professional laboratories at the Faculty, firstly without the participation of patients (Center of Medical Simulation)

Practical training in medical professions is obligatory and regulated by the law of the European Union

ergonomics of work in medical professions

work safety in hospitals - worker and patient safety

"Vision zero" - the concept of total elimination of work accidents

skin diseases as a reason for workers professional deactivation

chemical and radiological threats in medical professions (exposure to chemical irritants, cytostatics, ionizing radiation, anesthetics)

psychosomatic factors affecting the professional deactivation of medical workers

Research works are carried out in the departments by academic teachers with the help of students included in teams

The Faculty implements both, university and national projects (NCN, NCBR) as well as European projects - financed from EU funds

Separate research and activities promoting science are conducted by the Students' Self-Government and Student Science Clubs
