Eight European universities collaborate to deliver Europubhealth+, an innovative, integrated 2-year Master course for students wishing to engage in a public health career.

Emphasizing at its core the urgent need to build sustainable health systems whilst addressing health inequalities, Europubhealth+ provides multi-disciplinary training delivered in a unique multi-cultural environment. It brings students the necessary competences for innovative public health professionals, leading evidence-based decision making at the local, national or global levels.

Europubhealth has been recognized as a Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree of Excellence and supported by the Erasmus+ programme of the European Union since 2006. More than a decade after its launch, the programme now enjoys a vibrant international network of public health professionals and academics, and more than 350 graduates of 80 different nationalities.

## Access Profiles and Career Opportunities

Europubhealth+ is aimed at students with a strong interest in applied public health. Their academic background may be from various disciplines including clinical sciences (medicine, nursing, pharmacy), social sciences (sociology, economics, law, political sciences), management or engineering.

Professional opportunities vary according to the specialization undertaken and cover management of social and healthcare institutions, implementation and assessment of public health policies, management of health programmes, risk management and assessment, inspection and evaluation, audit and consulting, education and research. Europubhealth+ graduates are capable of working towards managing sustainable and equitable health systems.

## Mobility Tracks

Students can choose to begin with the first year either in English at the University College Dublin (Ireland) or the University of Sheffield (UK), or in Spanish at the Andalusian School of Public Health – University of Granada (Spain), or in French at the University of Liege (Belgium).

The second year specialisation course has to be followed in a different country than Year 1.

## Admission Criteria

To be eligible, applicants must fulfil the following conditions:

- Having at least a **university Bachelor degree or recognised equivalent** (180 ECTS).
- Being **proficient in the languages** suitable for the chosen mobility combination, i.e. either:
  - English
  - English + French
  - English + Spanish
  - English + Spanish + French
- Submit a **complete online application form** on <http://emundus.izp.cm-uj.krakow.pl> and provide all the supporting documents required, **in English**, before the indicated deadline.

## Awarded Degree

Upon completion of the 120 ECTS credits, students receive a **double degree** (two national Master's degrees) delivered by the universities which hosted them during their first and second year, as well as a **Europubhealth+ certificate** and **joint diploma supplement** delivered on behalf of the whole consortium.

## Participation Costs

Participation costs for the 2-year course are as follow:

- 11.000€ for European students
- 16.000€ for Non-European students

### Students

#### Applications Deadlines for September 2020 intake:

1. **22<sup>nd</sup> January 2022** for candidates applying for an Erasmus+:Erasmus Mundus Scholarship.
2. **2<sup>nd</sup> March 2022** for Non-European candidates applying for the University of Liege (Belgium) as self-funded students.
3. **10<sup>th</sup> May 2022** for all candidates applying as self-funded students.

**Visiting Professors** can apply for teaching in the programme anytime during the academic year. Specific Erasmus+ scholarships are also available for visiting professors.
