Martin McKee is Professor of European Public Health at LSHTM, London School of Hygiene & Tropical Medicine. He qualified in medicine in Northern Ireland and subsequently trained in public health in London. He manages a large research team studying the health effects of social, economic, and political transition. He has published over 1,200 papers in peer-reviewed journals and he is author or editor of 46 books. He is in the top 1% of researchers by citations across all disciplines in the Clarivate world rankings.

His contributions to health policy in Europe have been recognized by election to Fellowship of the UK Academy of Medical Sciences, Foreign Associate Membership of Institute of Medicine of the US National Academies of Sciences, and membership of Academia Europaea. He has also been awarded 6 honorary doctorates. In 2003 he was awarded the Andrija Stampar medal by the Association of Schools of Public Health in European Region (ASPHER) and in 2005 he was made a Commander of the Order of the British Empire (CBE) for services to health care in Europe.
