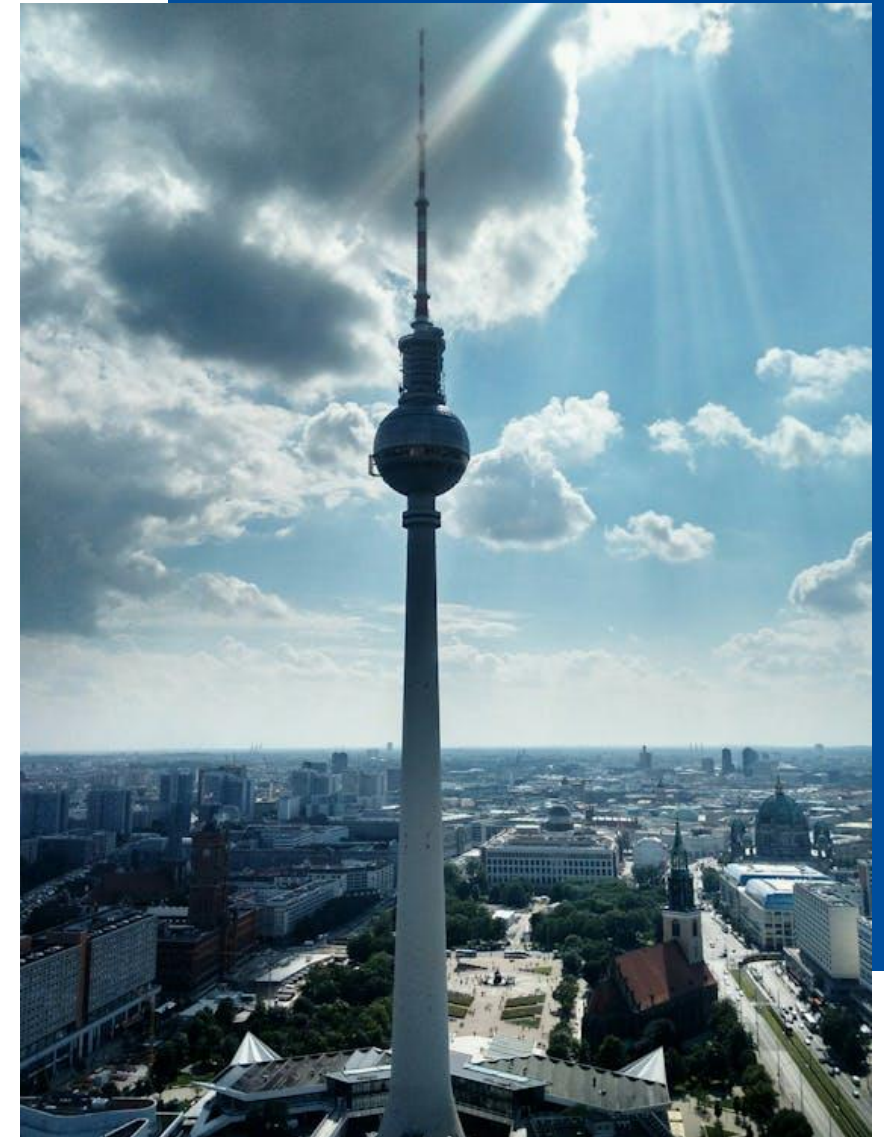


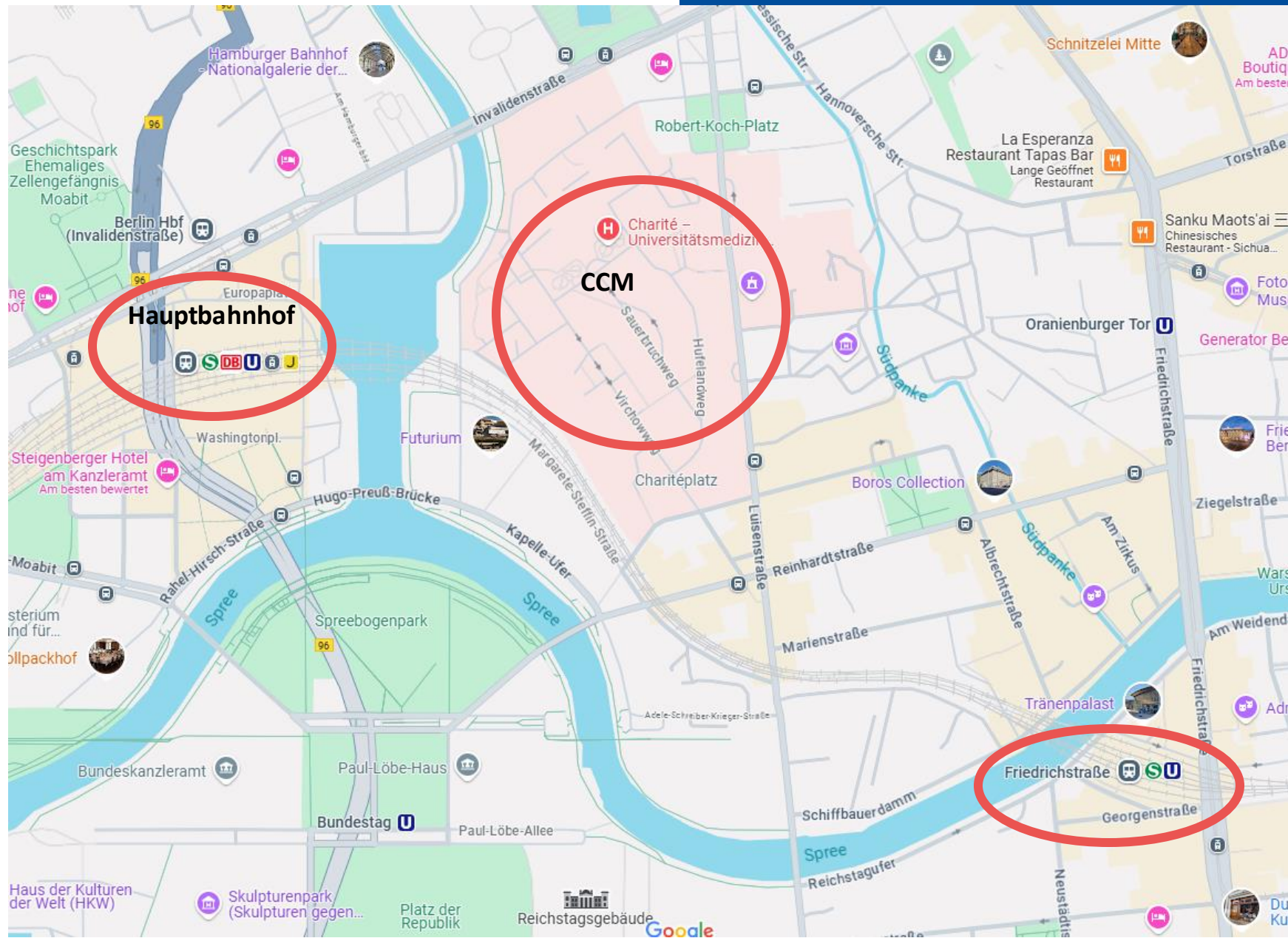

Places to Stay

Berlin has great public transportation so you can stay anywhere. We recommend staying in Berlin Mitte, close to Berlin's main train station **Hauptbahnhof** or S-Bahn **Friedrichstrasse**. The area around the main train station is safe and central, though it may be a little noisy!

The **Charité Mitte Campus (CCM)** is walking distance. We will be holding the ASPHER General Assembly at CCM on Wednesday, June 25 and the Conference Proceedings on Thursday, June 26, 2025.

Airport Transfer

There are a number of direct City Trains from Flughafen BER to Berlin Hauptbahnhof

- Regular ticket price: €4,70
- S-Bahn takes about 50 minutes
- RE / RB takes about 35 minutes

A taxi will cost about €60

How to get from Hauptbahnhof to CVK

- Share a taxi
- Walk (or bike)
 - 3 km / 45 Minutes
 - follow the river through Invaliden Friedhof and Uferpark am Nordhafen
- Public Transportation
 - Take the Tram M10 from Hauptbahnhof to Turmstr. (9 minutes)
 - Transfer to the Subway, U9 to Amrumer Str. (4 minutes)
 - Then walk across campus (10 minutes)
- CVK stops are
 - S-Bahn Westhafen
 - U9 Amrumer Str
 - M13 M50 Bus 106 Virchow Klinikum

- East side city center and shopping district **Alexanderplatz**
- West side city center and shopping district **Ku' Damm** - Gedächtniskirche - KaDeWe - Wittenbergplatz - Kantstr - Savigny Platz - a place for foodies who like Asian Cuisine!
- **Gendarmenmarkt** - built in 1688 with the most beautifully restored architecture
- **Boxhagener Platz** - local flair and a place for foodies!
- **Kulturbrauerei** - an industrial and architectural monument from the 19th century restored as an event location
- **Nollendorfplatz** - Winterfeldtplatz - Goltzstr - Akazienstr - Rathaus Schöneberg (where President JFK said „ich bin ein Berliner“)
- **Kottbusser Tor** - Mariannenplatz - Bethania - Engelbecken - like being in Istanbul
