

Position of Professor of public health at University of Lorraine, Nancy – France

The School of Public Health in Nancy, eastern France, has an opportunity for a position of university professor – hospital practitioner in public health (Section Conseil National des Universités [CNU] 4601) at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Lorraine. The qualified candidate will have proficiencies in the fields of health promotion, interventional research, and evaluation of actions and programs of public health, in practice and in research.

The missions of the position will be threefold:

- 1) **Teaching**, as a member of the School of Public Health team (n=650 students in 2016), Faculty of Medicine, University of Lorraine:
 - A medical curriculum including fundamentals in undergraduate, ECNi preparation in medical graduation, and public health specialist training
 - Undergraduate and graduate curricula, including a master degree in public health, with specialty in intervention in health promotion. Teaching relies on education by competencies and via the Internet to reach an international francophone audience.
- 2) In **research**, the position will be affiliated with the unit of public health EA 4360 APEMAC – *Adaptation, measure and evaluation in health. Interdisciplinary approaches* within the team *Measure and complex intervention in health* (MISC).

The candidate will have the opportunity to develop research in one or several of the following areas, as defined for the next unit contract 2018-2022:

- Concept and methods for complex interventions and measures of perceived health
- Favourable life style and health promotion
- Chronic patient, perceived health and adaptation process
- Evaluation of practice, strategies and health care organisation

- 3) **Hospital** activities will be hosted at the Clinical Investigation Centre (CIC) 1433 Clinical epidemiology (CIC-EC), supporting research developed in EA 4360 and specific to CIC, in collaboration with other modules at the CIC de Nancy (plurithematic and technologic innovation).

The CIC-EC module develops methodological skills in the fields of perceived health, evaluation of interventions, and medico-economic health technology assessment.

The candidate can be of French or European nationality, speaking French, must hold a Habilitation to Direct Research (HDR) or equivalent, and satisfy the conditions indicated by the section CNU 4601 available at <http://www.cpcnu.fr/web/sous-section-4601/recommandations-recrutement> .
