## Mediterranean and Black Sea Programme in Intervention Epidemiology Training (MediPIET), under the EU Initiative for Health Security

Since September, MediPIET Cohort 4 fellows are enrolled in the programme, and have participated in Introductory Course and Outbreak Investigation modules, in alignment with the ECDC Fellowship Programme. Ahead of the MediPIET Cohort 5 selection, a Call for expression of interest to become a MediPIET training site and undergo a training site appraisal is planned to be launched in January 2022.

The MediPIET Training Needs Assessment 2021 was launched on November 25th. This self-assessment asks for input from MediPIET National Focal Points and is aimed at identifying training needs and priorities in intervention epidemiology for their institutions and countries. It also asks about existing workforce training resources and preferred learning and capacity building methods. Responses are expected by the end of January 2022.
